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# CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

U.S. SECURITIES AND

ALFONSO SIMON, JR. ENJOINED

EXCHANGE COMMISSION

The New York Regional Office announced that the Honorable Morris E. Lasker, U.S. District Judge for the Southern District of New York, has signed a final judgment of permanent injunction enjoining Alfonso Simon, Jr. of New York, New York, from further violations of the beneficial ownership reporting provisions of the securities laws. Simon consented to the entry of the injunction without admitting or denying the allegations contained in the complaint. (SEC v. Gilbert, et al., S.D.N.Y., 76 Civil 366 MEL). (LR-8920)

#### CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

FORMER CENCO INCORPORATED OFFICERS CONVICTED

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on October 29 three former employees of Cenco Incorporated were found guilty as charged of conspiracy, securities fraud, mail fraud and false filings with the Commission. Ralph Read, former Cenco president, was convicted as charged of thirty-three counts of the indictment. Ronald Speigel, former executive vice president of Cenco Medical Health, was convicted as charged of thirty counts of the indictment. Howard Swiger, former treasurer of the Medical Health Group, was convicted as charged of thirty counts of the indictment. Additionally, two others named in the indictment, Bernard Magdovitz and Jack Coulson pled guilty to charges contained in the indictment. Robert Smith, former president of a Cenco subsidiary, S-P Drug, was acquitted. Sentencing of Read, Speigal and Swiger is set for December 21. (U.S. v. Ralph Read, et al., N.D. III., 79 CR 277). #### HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

MIDDLE SOUTH UTILITIES, INC.

#### NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The American Stock Exchange, Inc. has filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-Amex-79-19) to delete Commentary .01 of Amex Rule 959 which requires that closing sell orders at \$.01 which have been placed in the cabinet for execution and which cannot be executed immediately must be filed in time sequence with any orders to sell at 1/16 in the regular-way auction market. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of November 12. (Rel. 34-16334)

#### APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES
