## 714. Imposition of Fines for Minor Rule Violations

- (a) (c) No change.
- The Exchange shall specify in clause (e) of this Rule 714 the types of (d) violations of Rules of the Exchange that will be considered minor rule violations for purposes of this Rule 714 and a fine schedule for such violations. Any fine schedule may allow for warning letters to be issued for first-time violations or violators and shall provide for progressively larger fines for recurring violations. Nothing in this Rule 714 shall require the Exchange to impose a fine pursuant to this Rule 714 with respect to the violation of any provision of the Rules of the Exchange included in any listing of minor rule violations. In addition, the Exchange may[,] proceed under the Exchange's formal disciplinary rules as set forth in Rules 702 through 713, rather than under this Rule 714, whenever it determines that any violation is intentional, egregious or otherwise not minor in nature[,] or that the number of recurring violations of a particular type within the rolling time period under the fine schedule for that type of violation warrants a formal disciplinary proceeding [proceed under the Exchange's formal disciplinary rules as set forth in Rules 702 through 713, rather than under this Rule 714].
