.10 The Exchange may list and trade options on shares of the SPDR® Gold Trust (symbol: GLD), iShares COMEX Gold Trust (symbol: IAU), the iShares Silver Trust (symbol: SLV), the ETFS Silver Trust (symbol: SIVR), the ETFS Gold Trust (symbol: SGOL), the ETFS Palladium Trust (symbol: PALL), [and] the ETFS Platinum Trust (symbol: PPLT) ”), the Bitwise Bitcoin ETF (symbol: BITC), the Grayscale Bitcoin Trust (BTC) (symbol: GBTC), and any trust that holds bitcoin, pursuant to Rules 915 and 916.

.11 For purposes of Commentary .07 of this Rule 916, shares of the SPDR® Gold Trust (symbol: GLD), iShares COMEX Gold Trust (symbol: IAU), the iShares Silver Trust (symbol: SLV), and the ETFS Silver Trust (symbol: SIVR) and the ETFS Gold Trust (symbol: SGOL), the ETFS Palladium Trust (symbol: PALL), [and] the ETFS Platinum Trust (symbol: PPLT), the Bitwise Bitcoin ETF (symbol: BITC), the Grayscale Bitcoin Trust (BTC) (symbol: GBTC), and any trust that holds bitcoin, are deemed to be “Exchange-Traded Fund Shares.”
